It is proposed to organize a Chicago Area Chapter of the Health Physics Society. Active participation in such a group will not only be an important step forward for the overall profession but will be of extreme benefit to all Health Physicists in the Chicago Area.

An Organizational Meeting will be held at 2:00 P. M. on Saturday, March 25, 1961, Building D-2 Conference Room at Argonne National Laboratory. The purpose of this meeting will be to complete all requirements necessary for charterage by the Health Physics Society.

Primarily, this meeting will consist of the approval of the bylaws for our proposed chapter, nomination of officers, and the signing of the petition.

Immediately following the business meeting a social and dinner will be held in the private dining room of the Woodbine Restaurant located on the former Route 66. Maps will be available at the meeting for all those present that are not familiar with the location of the Woodbine.

It is imperative that as many as possible attend this organizational meeting in order that the required number of signatures be presented on the petition. If we are successful, it is hoped that the Chicago Area Chapter of the Health Physics Society will receive its charter at the June, 1961, meeting of the Society in Las Vegas.

Also requested is that you submit \$1.00 in the enclosed return envelope. This money will be used to carry on the business of the proposed chapter for the remainder of this calendar year. You will be credited with this payment and this sum will be applied to the first active years dues in 1962. As this payment will automatically entitle you to voting privileges, it is important that it be submitted even though you are unable to attend the meeting.

The dinner will cost \$2.25 but will be well worth the price, as it consists of all the chicken you can eat, French fried potatoes, rolls and butter, coffee, cheese and crackers, herring, and includes all taxes and tips. The time for the dinner has been set at 6:00 P. M.

As a final reminder, this will be your chapter; its value will depend on you, and your interest will determine the gain you will
