**To Emily Couric Clinical Cancer Center:**

**From Richmond:** Take I-64 West (to Charlottesville). Take I-295 West to VA-20, exit-121, toward Charlottesville/Scottsville. Turn right onto Monticello Ave/VA-20. Turn left onto Elliot Ave. (just past AltaVista Ave., Sojourner United Church is on the corner). Elliot Ave becomes Cherry Ave. Turn right onto Roosevelt Brown Blvd. (just past 9<sup>th</sup> St. SW). Turn left onto Crispell Dr. Stay straight to go onto to Lee Street. Visitor parking is available on Lee Street Parking Garage.

**From DC:** I-66 West, take exit 43A onto US-29 S toward Gainesville/Warrenton. Travel 52 miles. US-29 S becomes N Seminole Trail (27 miles). Stay on US-29 S/N Seminole Trail onto Emmet Street (1.5 mi.) Turn left onto University Ave/US-250 Bus E. Continue to follow US-250 Bus E. (.68 mi.). Turn right onto Jefferson Park Ave. (Jefferson Baptist is on the corner). Turn left onto Lee Street. Emily Couric Center is on the Right. Parking is on Lee Street in the Garage.
